

**LaVerne Noyes  
Scholarship Application 2017-2018  
Application Deadline: March 10, 2017**

The LaVerne Noyes Scholarship is for descendants of those who served in the U.S. Army or Navy *before May 12, 1918*, served overseas during World War I or died in service during World War I.

The LaVerne Noyes Scholarship is awarded based on demonstrated financial need as determined by filing the FAFSA by March 1<sup>st</sup> of the academic year. Applicants who do not demonstrate financial need will not be awarded the scholarship.

The Laverne Noyes Scholarship covers tuition and fees only. If tuition and fees are being paid by another source, the scholarship will not be offered to the student.

**Instructions: Provide the following documents to the Purdue University Northwest Office of Financial Aid.**

1. Copy of serviceman's Discharge Certificate.
2. Verification of applicant's relationship to serviceman. Provide notarized statement from parent attesting to relationship or provide copies of all birth certificates necessary to illustrate student's relationship to service person.
3. Verification of one of the following criteria:
  - a. **\*Service began before May 12, 1918.**
  - b. **\*Service was overseas during WWI.**
  - c. **\*Serviceman died in service during WWI.** (This information is usually found on enlistment and/or discharge document.)

**\*Please do not send original documents. Photocopies are acceptable.**
